

How to Apply Decals

1. Choose a spot



The best surfaces for adhesive vinyl decals are hard, smooth surfaces like glass, metal, or smooth plastic. Avoid porous surfaces like wood, fabric, pets, or similar surfaces.

2. Clean the surface



Use an alcohol-based cleaner to remove dirt and grease from the surface. Make sure to let it dry completely before applying the decal.

3. Remove the backing paper



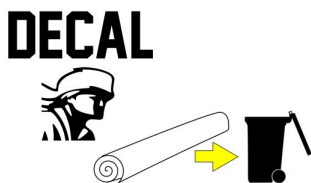
Carefully peel off the white backing paper to reveal the decal's sticky side, making sure that none of the decal stays on the paper. If it does, just push the paper back down with your finger and try peeling again.

4. Apply the decal center-out



Carefully align the decal where you want it without letting it touch the surface. Bend it slightly so the center bends away from you toward the surface. Let the center of the decal touch the surface first, then gently allow the rest of it to adhere as you push towards the surface.

5. Remove the transfer sheet



Once the decal is applied, peel the translucent transfer sheet off and toss it out. It's usually easier to peel off from a corner, working diagonally.

6. Enjoy your decal!
